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Economic Development Committee Meeting Tuesday, Feb. 7, 2023

The meeting began at 7 PM with the Pledge of Allegiance.

All attendees were welcome. Mr. Accomando stated that he was the Chair of the Committee and that his Co-Chair Mr. Smith will be handling Committee Business tonight. Mr. Caruso asked to address the attendees at this time. He expressed his concern on how the applications were being filled out and noting that many mistakes were taking place. Mr. Accomando also mentioned that he caught many careless mistakes that create extra work for Mr. Caruso. Mr. Smith omitted the reading of the conduct document. No residents in attendance at this meeting. Each was advised that when called upon to state name, position and an overview of the establishment. There were 10 Renewals and 1 New License, all were in attendance except one. Mr. Smith called on each one separately and went over the P.O. Reports. There was one incident that took place at one establishment that needed to be addressed. Mr. Smith called on the owners for some clarification. The owners explained what happened and the steps they are taking to prevent this from happening again. Mr. Accomando noted that he talked to Sergeant Major about the incident and they were very cooperative. The Committee engaged as well. Mr. Accomando noted that the establishment not present was only a seasonal License at Orchard Beach and there were no problems with the P.O, Report. At this time Mr. Smith called for a motion to accept the Renewals. It was made by Mr. Bieder and seconded by Mr. Roberts and voted on unanimously.
