The meeting commenced at 7 p.m. Chairperson Russo asked all committee chairpersons to discuss upcoming resolutions in preparation for the General Board meeting on Thursday, June 20. The Full Board agenda features Housing and Zoning resolutions that were developed by the Housing and Zoning Committee. Chairperson Russo reminded the Executive Board to closely follow parliamentary procedure.

District Manager Cruz informed the Executive Board that the Outdoor Dining application is slated to close on August 1. To date, CB #10 has received only three, but the District Manager is anticipating more applications throughout the summer. The Executive Board voted for the following resolution which was proposed by T. Accomando and seconded by D. Hunt and unanimously approved by all. This resolution will allow for the Municipal Services Committee to hold a public hearing and execute a vote on behalf of the Full Board due to the difficulty of meeting quorum during the summer months.

“Resolved... at the recommendation of the Executive Board to allow for the Municipal Services Committee to conduct public hearings and vote on behalf of the Full Board on Outdoor Dining Applications for the period of July 1st 2024 to August 30th, 2024 and that this be forwarded to the Full Board for its approval.”

District Manager Cruz informed the Executive Board that the office received a community notification from 3653 East Tremont Avenue. A public hearing will have to occur if the property owner intends to go forward. Executive Board Members were displeased as smoke shops that are allegedly selling cannabis and tobacco without permit are still operational.

The meeting closed at roughly 8 p.m. by a vote of adjournment.
