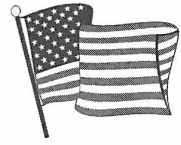

Ms. Catherina Gioino, Community Engagement Specialist, from the VEO ride company spoke before the committee. VEO strives to hire locally, has met FDNY safety requirements, and will be expanding to Queens in the late spring. Ms. Gioino added that the speed capacity is between 8-15 miles; rate is \$.39 per minute and there is a program for low income riders. Abuses include warnings for violations and additional charges for incorrect parking. There are vehicles available for the disabled.

Old Business: M. Caruso is requesting an agenda item be added to February’s meeting on the City Island Con Edison gas line project and the impact on the Gateway Project.

New Business: A concern was raised that the Unionport Bridge project is behind schedule and should have already been completed. Ms. Brockington raised concerns about the trash issue at MS101 with a request that the District Manager speak with the school.
