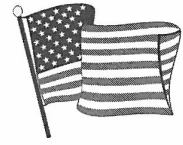

Borough Commissioner Perez introduced himself and introduced department staff, Jesus Soto. Commissioner López spoke of how the Committee should file concerns and complaints which could be through its website. Commissioner Perez took questions and comments from committee members on area concerns.

Jonathan Flynn presented on the Westchester Yard Flood Mitigation Project. The rail yard is located along Waters Place between Eastchester Road and Westchester Avenue. There will be new flood walls, flood gates, security fencing and security gates. The project will take roughly 4 years. The Waters Place side will have the flood wall.

P. Del-Debbio reporter on the Bronx SWAB. Composting is no longer funded. The rollout is open-ended. In December 2023, DSNY will take over compost from schools. The SWAB met in January 2024. It is reviewing the organization itself and its responsibilities.

N. Rosario nominated and M. Caruso seconded the nominations of R. Baez as Chairperson and Joseph Mondello as Co-Chairperson. The vote was unanimously approved.
