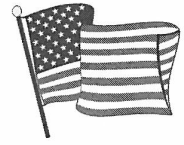

The Committee unanimously approved a street renaming in honor of Preston High School at Schurz Avenue and Brinsmade Avenue. Council Majority Leader Farias's office presented us with a letter and will also gather petition signatures.

After voting items, the Committee heard presentations from the State of New York Department of Transportation and the Propel New York electric transmission project. The Board Office has both presentations and will upload both presentations on the Board's website.

The State of New York DOT presented its Logan Avenue overpass construction project. The plan is to improve the overall condition of the existing bridge. It will replace decks and sidewalk. It will install new pedestrian ramps. It will repave streets. It will replace street lampposts and traffic signals. There will be structural steel repairs and re-painting of steel. There will be new under-deck highway lighting. There will be a temporary loss of 5 spaces for up to 8 months. There will be a community liaison. January 2026 is the anticipated construction start date which will last through January 2028. Members made recommendations to better traffic signals and push button signals to help with pedestrians. Members were adamant that this project will severely worsen already bad traffic at the intersection. State DOT will continue to do outreach to the community groups and schools to better prepare them for this intensive construction project. There will always be two flaggers to help with traffic mitigation. The Committee asked that the traffic agents work until the latter part of the evening.
