Chair Mondello opened the Committee with the Pledge of Allegiance.

The City of New York Department of Transportation presented its plan to convert part of Baychester Avenue between Aldrich Street and Rombouts Avenue into one lane while adding parking lanes on the southwest side of Baychester Avenue and school bus loading zones that will be in effect on school days between 7 a.m. and 4 p.m. There will be a removal of angled parking on Darrow Place in order to allow bus loading zones between the hours of 7 a.m. and 4 p.m. On Baychester Avenue, there will be a net of 62 new parking spaces because of these changes. Committee Member M. Fludd requested that NYCDOT review its plans with emergency services agencies as vehicles often must by pass double and triple parked cars and drive over medians to get to emergencies. The public was able to pose questions. Residents were concerned that removing a lane would be harmful on the southbound Baychester Avenue side. School administrators remarked that adding bus loading zones on Darrow Place will make walks longer for students.

The meeting closed at roughly 8:45 p.m.
