The meeting began promptly at 7 p.m. with our Pledge of Allegiance.

Mr. A. Eldin discussed the Rodman's Neck capital project updates. Presently, there are 6 outdoor ranges. The NYPD will demolish three. Altogether, Rodman's Neck is a four-phase project. Phase 4's bidding procedures will begin next month. First three phases successfully came under budget. Fourth phase includes building the indoor facilities. Total completion is expected by September 2029. Indoor ranges should be completed by 2028. In addition, there will be storm water mitigation as part of the overall project. The overall budget is \$270 million.

The City of New York Department of Design and Construction and NYPL presented the features of the new Westchester Square Library. The new location's address is 5 Westchester Square. The existing branch will close but will remain operational while the new facility is under construction. It will be a two-story, fully accessible building. There will be separate recreational spaces for children, teenagers and adults. It is fully funded as Borough President Gibson and City Council Member Farías secured the final resources in FY24. This is a "design-build" project which combines the building and design contracts. There will be a single point of contact with regards to its construction. NYC DDC will project manage the construction. Construction will begin in 2028. The project's completion date is Winter 2030.

B. Goldberg presented the Long Island Sound Partnership's New York Sea Grant program. It is federal and academic program between Cornell and Stony Brook University. It works to promote healthy coastal ecosystems and resilient communities and economies.
