Executive Board Meeting
November 14, 2022, 7:00PM

Present: T. Accomando, R. Bieder, T. Chambers, T. Franklin, P. Cantillo, M. Musano, N. Rosario, C. Isaies

Absent: L. Popovic and J. Russo

1st Vice Chair Chambers started the meeting at 7:11pm with the Pledge of Allegiance.

R. Bieder reported for Municipal Services that we're having a meeting with DOT tomorrow regarding the "City Island Gateway Project" and Scooter program becoming permanent. The Scooter Program was supposed to get back to us about remotely stopping sidewalk riding and picking up abandoned units. R. Bieder will update us on Thursday. There is also an issue with the zip car, car sharing programs paying for off-street parking which will eliminate much-needed parking spaces. District Manager Cruz mentioned that the NY Post contacted us about the zip-car issue. Zip car should pay for off street parking.

T. Accomando reported for Economic Development. We had one issue with one location, the owner came in voluntarily and Sergeant Major suggested we continue to work with this establishment. All concerns were addressed (underage drinking and open past hours of operation). Caliente, Seafood King and Archie's received some hate mail. T. Accomando followed up with Det. Rodriguez who is optimistic that they will find the culprit.

T. Franklin reported for Parks and Recreation. There was no meeting due to no agenda teams and no current issues.

N. Rosario reported for Health Services. Dr. Mansour come from Montefiore and reported on COPD and lung transports and the new liaison Jane Foster attended the meeting. We're seeking an explanation as to why the construction on the hospital has stopped.

A. Torres reported on Youth and Education and the new superintendent came to the last meeting. Truman speaker came to give us updates on Truman's afterschool program. 79 parents came out to "how to become a non-profit" meeting and it was very successful. Thanksgiving turkey and meal getaway in neighborhood this Saturday at the Food pantry at Bruckner and Edson.
