Meeting commenced at 7:35 pm with Pledge of Allegiance. Chairperson Russo reminded the Executive Board that elections will be by roll call vote.

Economic Development Chairperson Accomando added that there were no community concerns. However, establishments are struggling due to the pandemic. Crosstown Diner reported feeling being targeted and subject to excessive inspections.

Municipal Services Chairperson Velazquez had nothing to report and no resolutions. MS Committee will continue to assist Health Committee with testing and vaccine sites. Chairperson Popovic discussed Housing and Zoning regarding Crab Shanty on City Island. The leaseholder obtained the architect attorney regarding zoning change. The community didn't seem to be against it, but another meeting will be held before the Committee takes a position.

Chairperson Bieder spoke on the Youth and Education Committee. Yankee grants may be coming soon, according to the District Manager. Angela Torres was honored at the Power Women of the Bronx. Schools are getting laptops/tablets. Technology requests seem to be declining despite some eagerness to return to classrooms when permissible.

Chairperson Franklin did not have a Parks Meeting. Chairperson Franklin will attend on behalf of the Board a Department of Parks meeting regarding the Orchard Beach State Park.

Chairperson Velazquez and Chairperson Rosario discussed a townhall regarding the different vaccines and its availability. It is scheduled for early January or February. The meeting ended by vote of adjournment which was unanimously approved at 8:33PM.
