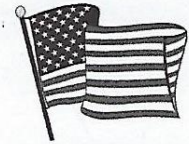

Economic Development Committee Meeting Tuesday, March 2, 2021

The meeting began at 7:30 PM with the Pledge of Allegiance. Mr. Accomando thanked all in attendance. He then addressed all establishments at this time and said when their establishment is called upon to state name and position at that establishment and how they have been managing their business. And if there has been any incidence at the location. The committee then went on to address the Renewals. Mr. Accomando called on each establishment separately and addressed some incidents that concerned him and the committee for some clarification. After a discussion between the establishments and the committee members. The Chairman made a motion to accept the renewals and it was made by Mr. Bieder and seconded by Mr. Popovic.
