The New York State Department of Transportation provided a presentation of their proposed I-95 modifications to reduce and bottlenecking between Pelham Bay Station and Co-Op City. It is a very ambitious proposal that will require coordination from various city and state agencies including the respective DOT's and Parks. Funding sources include the federal government. The modifications will affect drivers on I-95, the Hutch and Pelham Parkway.

There were many questions and concerns raised but as the project goes through the process there may be modifications. Further committee review will take place as the designs start to take shape and the contractor selection process begins.
