The meeting commenced at 7:38 P.M. with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Nicole D'Agostino formally requested a request for a street renaming of East Tremont Avenue and Miles Avenue in honor of her husband, Mario D'Agostino. Mrs. D'Agostino gathered over one thousand online signatures through a change.org petition.

The motion was presented by Chairperson Velazquez. It was accepted by R. Bieder and seconded by T. Accomando. It was approved a majority. D. Noble was ineligible to vote.

Old business items were regarding use of NYC DOT website and 311 to request signage. D. Noble mentioned MTABT is storing its equipment within the community. T.
