GUESTS: Stephen Caruso, Dept of Sanitation; Christopher Velez; Patricia Charles, CB 11 board member; and Sarah Delany.

No quorum was present for the meeting, but it was called to order at 7:00 p.m.

1. Plastic bag ban in effect March 1st. There will no longer be free plastic bags given, cost is 5 cents a bag.
2. Increase monies for supplemental cleaning. Clean up approximately 8-6 million. Every district increase in cleaning.
3. Councilman Ritchie Torre's district – \$260,000 given to fund additional services for cleaning.
4. Snow removal started early; in October. Additional staffing on 4-12 midnight shift. Enough personal on staff to man all snow equipment.
5. 1263 Burke Avenue - Corner of Burke and Throop Avenues- excessive amount of sanitation tickets. Complaint will be given to Sanitation by calling them to explaining that the house is not vacant and garbage should be picked up..
6. There are 60 Sanitation city workers city wide.
