No quorum was present for the meeting, but it was called to order at 7:00 p.m.

- 1. Plastic bag ban in effect March 1st. There will no longer be free plastic bags given, cost is 5 cents a bag.
- 2. Increase monies for supplemental cleaning. Clean up approximately 8-6 million. Every district increase in cleaning.
- 3. Councilman Ritchie Torre's district \$260,000 given to fund additional services for cleaning.
- 4. Snow removal started early; in October. Additional staffing on 4-12 midnight shift. Enough personal on staff to man all snow equipment.
- 5. 1263 Burke Avenue Corner of Burke and Throop Avenues- excessive amount of sanitation tickets. Complaint will be given to Sanitation by calling them to explaining that the house is not vacant and garbage should be picked up..
- 6. There are 60 Sanitation city workers city wide.
