- 1) Review of September Meeting Minutes
 - Updated correction to include Debra Kawalick
 - Option Transportation Corps: Morris Park Assn had no issue; will provide support.
- 2) Update on Metro-North train stations project
 - All new procurements are put on hold, and waiting on federal assistance for a transit related aid package
 - The project continues to move forward as far as advancing the design and conversations with groups like Amtrak and Metro North regarding the alignment issues
 - Continued dialogue with FTA assessing the environmental document which originally was supposed to be in May 2020 but now looking at potentially anytime b/w Oct-Dec 2020; will then be open for public response
 - Executed \$6b in contracts for 2020 until procurement issues are resolved.
 - Waiting on a formal letter explaining current status that will be shared with CB11 board and community.
- 3) Request for installation of a streetlight (Rhineland & Wallace Aves)
 - Van Nest Association request; was forwarded to DOT to do a study.

- 4) Speed Camera Installation Criteria
 - DOT will participate in November Committee to provide more details on criteria.
 - Pelham Parkway South Service Rd, by the exit ramp of the main road way which is a higher rate of speed; concerns about adjustment of the rate of speed; to be presented at November meeting with DOT

- 5) Old Business
 - a) Streets to Repave:
 - Will bring forward to DOT's attn in November

 - b) CB11 FY21 Budget
 - Email to Committee Chairs to review the FY21 budget priorities.
