- 2. DOT Presentation on Speed Cameras
 - Now allowed to have cameras at 750 locations citywide (not 750 cameras); It is now a quarter mile radius around a school; Cameras are now in operation from 6am-10pm; issued when 11 mph over the speed limit
 - Currently, at any given time there are only 150 red light cameras in the City.

 - Streets Discussed:
 - Lydig b/w Hone & Paulding

 - Frano: Speed bump
 - Traffic calming turns have been installed in several areas of the district
