Meeting began: 7:05 p.m.

1. December 2020 Minutes
Motion by Durrell Boahen to approve the December 2020 Minutes.
PASSED UNANIMOUSLY.
2. Wage discrepancy
 - a. Latina women: 55 cents for every dollar paid to a white male
 - b. Black women: 63 cents for every dollar paid to a white male
 - c. White women: 79 cents for every dollar paid to a white male
 - d. Asian women: 87 cents for every dollar paid to a white male(These statistics were obtained from the Center for Gender Equity.)
3. COVID-19 and PPE
 - a. 12.83% infection rate for Pelham Gardens and Allerton areas
 - b. 12.23% infection rate for Morris ParkSpeak to elected officials to provide PPE to the NYSCHA buildings and the areas in the district which have been greatly affected by COVID-19 and under-resourced.
Reach out to medical institutions to educate the district on the vaccine.
4. Membership to the Community Board #11
There are many people expressing interest in joining our board from various backgrounds.
Borough President makes appointments to the Board:
