- 6. Committee Reports
 - a. By-Laws

David Leavitt read the following proposed amendments:

- i. Revise Article IV, Section 5 of the CB11 By-Laws to allow the Treasurer (and only the Treasurer) to serve as Acting Vice Chair of the Board (when there is a vacancy in that position) without violating the existing rule prohibiting a Board officer from holding two officer positions at the same time
- ii. Revise Article IV, Section 2 and Article V, Section 5 of our By-Laws to allot only one vote to the Treasurer, when serving as Acting Vice Chair of the Board, at meetings of the Executive Board and at meetings of the Leadership Committee

Motion to <u>APPROVE</u> the amendments as read.

David requested board members read the following, proposed, bylaw amendments (which are not up for a vote this month):

- i. Update Article V, Section 2 of the BxCB11 By-Laws to require a written reason for removal from a committee
- ii. Clarify the language in Article III, Section 4(a) and 4(b) regarding the number of committee and Full Board meeting absences that may serve as cause for removal from the Community Board. The number of committee and Full Board meetings that a board member may miss before being considered for removal from the Board will not change but the two sections will be re-drafted for clarity and for brevity. Additionally, the contents of the revised section(s) will be disseminated to the full board so that they are aware of their attendance requirements
- iii. Update Article III, Section 4(c)(2) so that e-mail notification is now permitted for a board member subject to removal from the Community Board (immediately followed by a telephone call), requesting acknowledgement from the board member within FIVE BUSINESS DAYS. If acknowledgment by the member subject to removal is <u>not</u> received by the Community Board Office within five business days, only then will notice by certified mail be required
- iv. Add a reference in the CB11 By-Laws to NYC's sexual harassment policy, add a weblink in the bylaws to the policy then in effect (as the city may periodically update the policy) and add a reminder in the bylaws that all board members are bound by the policy
- v. Update Article VI, Section 3 to require ULURP hearing notices be posted on the Board's website
- vi. Update Article VI, Section 9 to require the recitation Pledge of the Allegiance at the beginning of virtual meetings of the full board
- vii. Delete section VIII, Section 4 *Staff Resolution Committee* as these functions are exercised by the Ethics & Disciplinary Committee
- viii. Various grammatical, stylistic and organizational changes that are detailed in the committee meeting minutes

Discussion on street co-naming guidelines will be reviewsed by the Transportation Committee.
