- 49th NYPD Precinct Briefing
 Officer Mederos gave the following report:
 - Crime for the past 28 days is up
 - Primary causes are:
 - o Felony assaults are up 100%, from 17 incidents to 34
 - o Grand Larceny Auto up 85%, from 14 to 26
 - Year to date crime is up 44%, from 150 to 216
 - Compared to when Comp Stat began 29 years ago, felony assault up 175%, grand larceny up 30%
 - Shootings year to date: 6 compared to 1 last year
 - Domestic violence and grand larceny auto are trending
 - Key fobs do not secure vehicles
 - 1 incident reported today: female dropped off at Jacobi Medical Center pronounced deceased
