Meeting called to order.

1. 49th NYPD Precinct Briefing

Officer Mederos gave the following report:

- Crime is up 47.1% in index crimes as compared to this time last year (153 complaints compared to 104 complaints)
- Year to date: up 44.7% in index crimes (369 complaints compared to 255 complaints this time last year)
- Major drivers this year are grand larcenies (increase in fraudulent bank activity) and grand larcenies of automobiles (catalytic converter and tire rim thefts)

2. Gallery Session (Public Input)

R. Press inquired about theft of gasoline and if the Honda thefts were occurring in a certain area of the Precinct.

D. Finch inquired about shootings and fights happening recently between Britton Street and Allerton Avenue, and she inquired about Brady Court concerns.

E. Rodriguez inquired if there was any update regarding e-scooters driving on sidewalks and any reports of such incidents.
