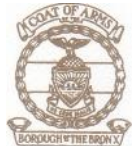

The New York State Department of Transportation (NYSDOT) is advising the public that a single lane closure will be in effect on eastbound Bruckner Boulevard from Bryant Avenue to Whittier Street beginning on or about Friday, March 19th, 2021 at 9:00 p.m. through approximately Monday, March 22nd, 2021 at 5:00 a.m. (weather permitting).

There will be signs posted to alert motorists and pedestrians where restrictions are in place and guide them around the closure.

Inclement weather could cause the start date to be rescheduled.

This work is part of the NYSDOT project to improve access to and from the Hunts Point Peninsula.

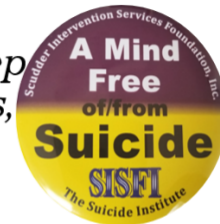
