The New York State Department of Transportation (NYSDOT) is advising the public that three (3) traffic lanes on eastbound Bruckner Expressway from Eastern Boulevard Bridge to Elder Avenue in the Bronx will be shifted to the south on or about Tuesday, April 6<sup>th</sup> at 10:00 p.m. through approximately Wednesday, April 7<sup>th</sup> at 5:00 a.m.

This new traffic pattern is necessary to prepare for roadway reconstruction of the Bruckner Expressway.

There will be signs and message boards posted to alert motorists of the nighttime roadwork and shifting lanes.

Inclement weather could cause the start date of the new traffic pattern to be rescheduled.

This work is part of the NYSDOT project to improve access to and from the Hunts Point Peninsula.

#### (WEATHER PERMITTING)

The New York State Department of Transportation (NYSDOT) is advising the public that two (2) eastbound Bruckner Expressway lanes will be shifted south to the eastbound Bruckner Boulevard: One (1) lane on Wednesday, April 7<sup>th</sup> at 9:00 p.m. through approximately Thursday, April 8<sup>th</sup> at 5:00 a.m. and the second lane on Thursday, April 8<sup>th</sup> at 9:00 p.m. through approximately Friday, April 9<sup>th</sup> at 5:00 a.m. (weather permitting).

All eastbound lanes on the Bruckner Expressway and Bruckner Boulevard will be maintained. Accessibility to local businesses on eastbound Bruckner Boulevard will also be maintained.

In addition, between Wednesday, April 7<sup>th</sup> and Friday, April 9<sup>th</sup> at 5:00 a.m. all eastbound Bruckner Expressway lanes will be split around the work zone and will come together again near Whittier Street.

Overnight travel delays should be expected due to final placement of barrier and line striping operations for the safe establishment of new traffic patterns and work zones.


This closure is necessary to create a work zone for Stage 3 work on the north side of the westbound Bruckner Expressway over the Railroad Truss Bridge.

There will be signs posted to alert motorists, commuters, and pedestrians where restrictions are in place and guide them around the closure.
