# Councilmember Vanessa L. Gibson's Report

Mr. Michael Ivory, representative from Councilmember Vanessa L. Gibson's office, provided the following Press Conference update:

On Monday, January 6<sup>th</sup>, Council Member Vanessa L. Gibson joined with elected officials and community stakeholders that included Public Advocate Jumaane Williams, Save Our Streets Bronx (S.O.S), Release the Grip (RTG) and the Third Avenue Business Improvement District to denounce the attack on Mr. Juan Fresnada and others impacted by violence. Mr. Fresnada and his partner were attacked in late December of 2019 after leaving a McDonald's in the Morrisania area. The collective called for an end to the violence occurring in our community and provided on-site resources that included RTG's recently unveiled mobile trauma van and the announcement of a "No Hate Fund" from Third Avenue Bid Director, Michael Brady.

Other attendees included Senator Luis Sepulveda, Assembly Member Michael Blake, Destination Tomorrow, Amida Care, the 42<sup>nd</sup> Precinct Council, the NYPD LGBT Outreach Unit, District Leader Cynthia Cox, Guns Down Life Up and many others.
