- **III.** Review of Previous Minutes
 - A. The minutes from the November meeting were reviewed and accepted.

IV. Follow-up from Previous Month

A. Water Main Break in Front of Webster House:

basis. As long as there is a demand for participation in Pickleball, the committee is in favor of this conversion.

2. A vote was taken and all were in favor of the motion.

B. Public Safety In Bronx CB7 Parks:

- 1. Incidents at local parks have been brought to the attention of the board. Although we have two parks with PEP officers, the officers remain in the building and do not observe what is happening in the park.
- 2. Joe Magneri mentioned the lack of PEP officers and he promised to check if PEP officers can supervise outdoors as opposed to remaining inside the recreation buildings.

C. Park Maintenance:

- 1. Joe Magneri has been interviewing candidates for summer help and currently his staff is being used as a roving crew for each park for maintenance tasks.
 - a) Garbage Pickup: Complaints regarding spillage when emptying trash bins were made. Joe will speak with his staff regarding this issue.
 - b) Condition of Parks: The parks have been cleaner than usual as a result of the lack of usage due to the cold weather.
 - c) Suggestions for Next Spring and Summer: Additional staff is needed during the summer months. The Bronx recently received 40 CPW's but the exact number for each district is not yet known.

D. Other Items:

- 1. A suggestion was made to dedicate a bench at the Oval in memory of Dwight Downer, who was tragically killed in a road collision. As a local volunteer football coach for the Bronx Buccaneers Football League, he spent hours working with youngsters at the Oval. The committee liked the suggestion and will report back next month on this possibility.
