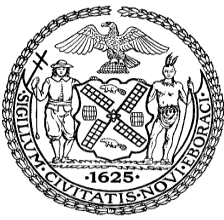
Help the MTA select stations for accessibility upgrades

Citi Bike Phase 3 Expansion

Starting in the Fall of 2025, NYC DOT in partnership with Lyft will expand and improve Citi Bike throughout the Bronx to meet the growing ridership demand and help ensure New Yorkers across the city have equitable access to the system. Service will expand further into Norwood and Riverdale in the Bronx.

An online feedback portal is available for people to identify locations where they would like to see Citi Bike stations, as well as areas not suitable for a Citi Bike station.

The portal will be open from mid-January to mid-April
