B. Fiscal Year 2027 Capital & Expense Budget Requests Review of FY26 Agency Responses: <u>https://bit.ly/42GezQl</u>

- 1. The committee determined that all expense items about DSNY and DEP will be resubmitted with additional information.
- 2.
