#### A. Pickleball Improvement Proposal at Williamsbridge Oval - Presentation by Daniel Amell (<u>https://bit.ly/42fzA2m</u>)

1. Mr. Amell, a local resident, presented several detailed proposals to convert some of the existing tennis courts to Pickleball courts. He discussed the popularity of the game and the need to provide a safer area than the one currently used for this activity. Suggestions were made for temporarily using the existing tennis courts by adding new markings. A proposal for any type of construction would need to be added to our capital budget. It was suggested that Mr. Amell also try to obtain funding for the project from his council members.

2. Joe Magneri, the Parks Manager, plans to bring the proposal to the Bronx Parks Commissioner. Joe also suggested the formation of a "Friends" group for Pickleball at the Oval. Since the game currently has a following of interested players at the Oval, it was also recommended that the status of these proposals be followed up on at each month's parks meeting.

## **B.** Department of Parks & Recreation Updates -

- 1. Maintenance issues were addressed, including dumping at Devoe Park, utilizing the Webster House, the need for additional garbage receptacles, and better anchoring of the "No Barbecuing" signs.
- 2. For staffing, several current workers have been promoted, but the summer staff numbers have not been determined.
- 3. Pamela Coleman, Recreation Specialist from Williamsbridge Oval, announced several upcoming activities, including the egg hunt and a family fitness event on May 16th.

- A. Several announcements were read, including the postponement of the ribbon-cutting ceremony at Harris Field, the Civic Engagement activity at Poe Park scheduled for April 12th, and the Egg Hunt planned for Williamsbridge Oval on April 19th.
