#### **B.** Douglaston Development: 2850 Webster Avenue

- 1. Joel Kolkmann provided an update on the anticipated completion date and the now open Housing Lottery for 130 Senior Apartments at 2850 Webster Avenue. The building houses a total of 188 units, in addition to the 130 units on the lottery system, 57 are reserved for formerly homeless individuals and 1 for the building's superintendent.
- 2. Residents will have access to 3.200 SF of communal spaces and on-site social services with multiple activities for seniors
- 3. The building will also house 13,000 SF for the Cherry Valley Supermarket
- 4. Paper applications can be requested from Fordham Bedford Housing Corporation. Applications must be postmarked or submitted by January 3rd, 2023.
