V. **Department of Parks' Updates**: Summer Staffing: To date, the district received 3 additional seasonal workers.

- 3. Frequency of mowing along Mosholu Parkway
- 4. Motorized biking at the Oval and Devoe Parks
- 5. Signage for Devoe Park
- 6. Infrequent garbage pick-up along Mosholu Parkway
- 7. Permits at Williamsbridge Oval
- 8. Opening of the Webster House

VI. Projects on Mosholu Parkway North East of Gun Hill Rd.:


