HEALTH & HOSPITAL COMMITTEE MINUTES

Thursday, November 18th, 2010 @ 6:30PM

- I. Health and Hospitals Committee joined the Traffic & Transportation Committee for a presentation by City Planning Transportation Division on Webster Avenue. After the presentation we discussed health committee's involvement in suggesting and finding participants for the upcoming Sunday street closings. Ideas discussed included; Smoke free Coalition, HIV mobile units and other screenings, health care providers such as health first, local youth groups, presentations by sports clubs in the community and health screenings provided by local hospitals.
- II. Committee discussed the following events
 - a. On World AIDS Day committee decided given the short amount of time available for planning an event during this time would not be possible
 - b. In regards to domestic violence committee discussed the possibility of a forum in March. Committee will look into the possibility of an artist to take part of the event.
