- I) Attendance sheet in file
- II) Board of Standard and Appeals Application for property at 205th St. West Fordham Road
 - A) Special 10 year permit to build a new 13,000 ft. BP Gas Station on West Fordham and Sedgwick Avenue
 - 1) There will be no Car Wash
 - 2) 59 Space Car Garage will be eliminated
 - 3) A 1680 ft. Convenience Store will be part of the construction
 - 4) Station will have 5 two sided pumps with 4 30 ft. Curb cuts
 - 5) Gaseteria is owner of property and BP Gas will be operator of site
 - 6) Community already has questions about the project and has asked for a follow up
 - B) City Planning presented Overview of Jerome Avenue Neighborhood Study
 - 1) Environmental review scoping of 73 Block area on Jerome Avenue
 - 2) 3 Blocks are in CB7 183rd to 184th
 - 3) Not at ULURP process yet
 - 4) Existing zones are C8, M1, C1, C2, C4
 - 5) Changes to R7, R7A, R8A, R9A
 - 6) This would permit the development of Residential Housing in the corridor
 - 7) Building heights could range from 8 stories up to 17 stories
 - 8) Commercial overlay is flexible and would not push out existing businesses
 - 9) Certain areas will not be rezoned
 - 10) Down Zoning is not being looked at. The area up to Bedford Park is not included in the study and there are no future plans to do it.
 - 11) Neighborhood Development Fund for up zoning contain funding to do research can be used to finance specific projects within the zoning area
