- II. Review of the Letter to the Board of Standards and Appeals
 - A. On March 30, 2011, the Land Use Committee made a motion to send a letter of opposition to the proposed development project is the North Manhattan Construction Corp at 186 St. George's Crescent. The committee reviewed the final draft of the letter addressed to the Board of Standards and Appeals.
 - B. No major objections were made to the letter, and the committee agreed that all points were properly documented. The letter was approved for release.
