PARKS AND RECREATION COMMITTEE MINUTES

Thursday, May 19, 2011 @ 6:30PM

- I. Attendance sheet on file.
- II. Anthony Riviuccio spoke on the increase of barbequing, soccer, and volley ball (south side) playing at Mosholu Parkway. The committee voted to send a letter to both the Parks Dept. and the 52 Pct to see if some type of enforcement at the time that these activities are taking place (Mon -Fri 2p 4p) can be provided. The Parks Dept. will reseed the areas where the ball playing has eroded the grass in the fall. Parks Dept. will see if no Ball Playing signs can be put up in the area. The committee will do a walkthrough of the area on Wednesday May 25, at 10am.
- III. Parks Dept. reported that at Williamsbridge Oval the contractor has more work to do on the basketball courts which has delayed the playground opening. The downed fence will be repaired by the contractor. Aqueduct Park still in schematic phase, after a review by Parks Commissioner it will be sent to CB7 for review. Devoe Park rest station electrician contractor in default which has backed up completion of work. Poe Park Information Center will be opening as soon as staff can be scheduled (no date given).
- IV. The committee voted to go forward with the site pick on Bailey Ave. for the Regatta Park Beautification Plan.
- V. The committee voted to send two letters to one to the Parks Dept. and the contractor asking them to do everything possible to have the work being done at Williamsbridge Oval Park, before end of summer.
- VI. The committee voted to send a letter to the Parks Dept. asking them to join us on a tour of the Holt Place entrance.
