PARKS & RECREATION COMMITTEE MEETING Monday, November 24, 2014 @ 6:30 PM

- I. Attendance: See sign-in sheet in file
- II. Holiday Tree Lighting:
 - A. Ms. Ferguson was asked to have someone trim the shrubs in front of the tree prior to Dec. 11th. Everyone was invited to attend this annual event. Flyers were distributed
- III. Plans for two construction projects were presented by David McConnell, Samir Rey and Judi Raymund. The three presenters were from the design division of the Department of Parks
 - A. Soccer Field at St. James Park:
 - 1. Slides were shown on the proposed conversion of three tennis courts to a soccer field
 - 2. The cost involved is \$735,000, which has been appropriated by the Mayor's Office and Councilman Cabrera. The field will be composed of astro-turf. Once the bidding is complete, the time frame for completion will be approximately 450 days
 - a. **<u>MOTION 1</u>**: The Parks' Committee recommends that the Board approve the design work for the conversion of three tennis courts at St. James Park to a soccer field
 - B. Whalen Park:
 - 1. Judi Raymund presented the slides and a description of the plans for the rehabilitation of Whalen Park
 - 2. The park will be divided into two parts. The side closest to the library will be for passive recreation. The other side of the park will be a toddler play area for youngsters from 2-5 years old. In addition to some small playground equipment, there will also be spray showers. The cost of the project is \$1,245,000. It should take about 2 years to complete, once construction is started
 - 3. After much discussion with community representatives, it was decided that the committee would request the following additions to the project:
 - a. Install several game tables on the passive recreation side of the park
 - b. Increase to 3 feet for the fencing along the backside of the park. The higher fence would grant better protection to the shrubs and plantings
 - c. The installation of a "setting" area in the adult section for the display of art work
 - 4. The residents attending also made a request for WiFi at Whalen
 - a. <u>MOTION 2</u>: The Parks' Committee recommends that the Board approve the design work for Whalen Park with the following additions:
 - i. Install several game tables on the passive recreation side of the park
