- I) Attendance Sheet on file
- II) Concerns about the Select Bus Service (BX12)
 - A) Another delivery window is needed for merchants between Sedgwick Avenue and University Avenue
 - B) Residents at Fordham Hill are upset that their bus stop was moved. A number of disabled and older individuals are having problems with the new stop locations
 - C) Individuals are unsure how to transfer from the local the bus to the BX 12 and vice versa.
 - D) There are problems with only the SBS BX12 buses going to Manhattan
 - 1) The Chair is trying to arrange meeting with the MTA for October
- III) Subway issues:
 - A) Bedford Park
 - 1) Vines are growing back on the platform and the front of the station is very dirty
 - B) Mosholu Parkway
 - 1) Now that the station has been re-done, when will MTA do to restore the parkland around the station?
 - C) What is the MTA's policy about posting subway work notices?
- IV) The carting of debris from Jerome Park Reservoir has been placed on hold. The announced truck route starts on Goulden Avenue to Bedford Park Boulevard, then onto Jerome Avenue to Fordham Road, down Fordham Road to the Major Deegan Expressway and then heads northbound. All work is on hold.

 - A) The Committee would like to push for more bike racks in the community
- VI) Street conditions, maintenance and speed reduction areas:
 - A) The Community Board office is compiling a list of streets that need work done.
