TRAFFIC & TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE MINUTES Monday, May 18th, 2009 @ 6:30PM

I. Old Business Items

- A. MTA fixed the broken grate in front of the Bronx's New School.
- B. DOT will be changing the parking signs on Gun Hill Road from Mosholu Parkway to Knox Place to allow Sunday parking.
- C. Andrew Ave Issues-District Manager is waiting for a police report on a car accident that occurred on Andrews Ave. The car was totaled and speed was involved. This report could be used in asking for a speed bump on Andrews Ave from Fordham to 183rd Street.
- D. Gun Hill Road and Bainbridge Ave Nighttime Lighting Survey- the District Manager will ask DOT for a copy of the survey.
- E. Bx#28 Bus Stop in front of Tracey Towers: The trees on the triangle are dead. Thus, a bus shelter could be built. This needs to be followed-up on.

II. New Business Items

- A. The Committee approved bringing a motion to the Community Board at the May 19, 2009 meeting that would state the following: "In honor of the Grand Course Centennial, CB7 would like car free Sundays on the Grand Course from Kingsbridge Road to Mosholu Parkway for July and August."
- B. Due to the Bronx's Week Parade on June 20th that will be held on Mosholu Parkway, the Bx#28 bus will be re-routed.
- C. The District Manager reported that Montefiore Medical Center, the Jerome BID, Lehman College and Bronx Lebanon Hospital will provide 66 banners for the Grand Concourse in honor of the Tree Museum.
- D. District Manager gave out copies of the NYC Graffiti Law.
