TRAFFIC & TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE MINUTES Wednesday, January 13th, 2010 @ 6:30 PM

- I. Angelo Diaz from Scott Towers expressed concern about the school buses from the Vallo bus company double parking while waiting to pick-up students at Bronx High School of Science.
 - A. The buses make it difficult for cars leaving the Scott Towers' parking lot on East 205 between Jerome and Paul Ave to see traffic.
 - B. The chair will look into the issues.
- II. Update on Projects: Bike Racks-A letter will be sent to DOT requesting that the bike racks in the two municipal parking lots in the CB7 area be upgraded and maintained. The lots are Jerome-190st and Jerome-Gun Hill Road.
- III. Tracy Towers Bus Stop-DM will contact DOT for an update on the bus shelter placement for the Route 28 stop. A green metal pole still needs to be removed.
- IV. MTA Concerns:
 - A. Re-seeding area by Mosholu Parkway Subway station-DM will contact MTA for the name of the contractor. It has been two years since the station was re-done and the staging area has not been replanted.
 - B. The MTA has stated that the 34 and 10 bus lines will not be eliminated.
 - C. Access a ride-Motion from CB7-"As CB7 has no handicapped accessible subways that serve Montefiore and North Central Bronx Hospitals, the Board request that the MTA's access-a –ride program does not change their door-door service for its clients."
 - D. Dark Exits on the D Subway line-DM will ask MTA to check lighting as well as signage at the non-staffed token booth entrance and exists at the 205th and Bedford Park stations.
