- I. Summer Walk/Weekend Project: The City has officially approved the project.
 - A. When: Sundays-July 24, July 31 and August 7
 - B. Time: 11:00 am to 5:00 pm
 - C. Location: 204th Street from Bainbridge Ave to Hull Ave (2blocks) The Fire Department will provide the smoke house for 2 of the dates.
- II. In response to a community businessman's request at the March meeting, the Committee looked at street parking on Webster Ave between 204th and 205th Street. As a result of the construction for the new school as well as cub cuts for the existing auto repair business, Webster Ave has a very limited amount of street parking in this area. The DOT cannot provide an additional parking space at this time.
- III. Mr. Brodie Enoch and Ms. Lori Landres from Transportation Alternatives made a presentation on the Rider Rebellion Campaign. Rider Rebellion is a list of rights for New York City Transit Riders. The Committee will discuss the campaign at its May meeting.
- IV. The Committee has started discussing what projects should be looked at for the next city budget cycle.
