TRAFFIC & TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE MINUTES

Thursday, May 12, 2011 @ 6:30 PM

- I. MTA-Kingsbridge Station B/D line
 - A. An elevator will be placed at the Southern End of the Kingsbridge B/D line subway stop.
 - 1. Work is scheduled to begin spring 2012.
 - 2. The 24 hour agent booth will be moved to the Southern Entrance.
 - 3. MTA will be back early 2012 to present work schedule.
 - B. At this time, there is no plan for anymore service reductions or fare increase.
- II. City Planning-Bedford Park Boulevard
 - A. A preliminary study of how to improve pedestrian issues on Bedford Park Boulevard was presented. Some things mentioned: better signage for points of interest needed, due to the wide sidewalks there can be more trees planted, improving bike route and more bike racks are needed.
- III. East Gun Hill Road Project Update
 - A. DOT is reviewing the suggestions made at the February-2011 community meeting and will hold another meeting in the fall.
- IV. New Business
 - A. The Committee learned that DEP will be installing new pipe connections along Goulden Ave. These pipes (48inches wide) are dealing with Croton Filtration Project work. MTA will look into the project and how it might affect bus travel.
 - B. In response to a request from the Committee, DOT is looking at specific conditions on East 211 St.
 - 1. A speed bump will be place on the roadway.
 - 2. The need for repaving the roadway will be looked at.
 - 3. The removal of "No parking signs" by a Woodlawn Cemetery entrance that is no longer being used will be looked at.
 - C. The Committee has started a list of streets that need to be repaved.
- V. Next meeting date will be Thursday, June 9, 2011 at the Community Board's office. Meeting adjourned.
