TRAFFIC & TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE MEETING

- I) Fordham Hill Neighborhood Association Group:
 - A) The Chair read a thank you note to the committee from the Fordham Hill Neighborhood Association Group which is working on extending the BX12 bus line. Although the project to extend the bus line is not viable at this time, the group appreciated all the suggestions and support that the Traffic and Transportation Committee gave them
- II) Discussion:
 - A) DOT will be having meeting to discuss increasing safety and mobility for pedestrians and bicyclists traveling between the Bronx and Manhattan across the Harlem River on Tuesday, June 23, 2015 6:30pm at Lehman College (Faculty Dining Room) Music Building. All are welcome to attend
- III) Requests:
 - A) The public school at 3177 Webster has requested the community board's assistance in getting a designated street parking area in front of the school for teachers. DOT no longer provides teacher parking areas. The committee will ask DOT if it can made the block of Webster that the school is located into a 4-hour maximum parking location. The block presently has a 2-hour maximum parking location
- IV) Committee Plans for September 2015 - June 2016:
 - A) Street Parking Availability:
 - 1) Will look at the CB7 area to see if any spaces can became legal street parking
 - 2) Create an informational sheet explaining what is needed when coming to the committee with a request
 - 3) Review traffic flow in specific areas; ask if DOT has information on these locations
 - 4) Do Tours of CB7. Save the date for Saturday, October 3, 2015 for a walking tour of Mosholu Parkway from Jerome to Webster Avenue
 - B) MTA Concerns:
 - 1) Webster Avenue to LaGuardia Bus Route and the "D" subway line at evening rush hour
 - 2) Left-hand turning lane/light at Fordham Road and Valentine Avenue
