• Introduction

A. Committee Description: The public safety & transportation committee represents the community's interests with regards to sanitation, crime, fire-ems, quality of life, NYS liquor license application recommendations, street activity permit applications, street re-naming application, transportation and acts as a liaison between community members and the New York Police Department & Fire Departments, NYC Department of Environmental Protection, NYC Department of Sanitation, NYC Department of Sanitation & NYS Liquor Authority.

Liquor License

- Isla Café 1859-61 Westchester Ave. #1114257 Renewal Application
 - Liquor License was passed on to new owner
 - o It has a bar
 - Same location for 2 years and first renewal
 - Closes at 2 AM on the weekdays, 4 AM on the weekends
 - DM Rivera already knows them and they are compliant with cameras and security
 - Olivia's is across the street and closes at 3, people usually come across but their security is selective, so there aren't any problems
 - During the summertime, there are a lot of cars parked and even double parked but that isn't the owner's fault
 - CB9 will send letter to SLA on Monday
- El Mocajete 1504-1508 Westchester Ave. #1271989 Renewal Application
 - DM Rivera has no problems with the restaurant and very low-key
 - There were no 311 complaints and the NCO has no issues with them
 - It is primarily a restaurant
 - Will mail letter to SLA by Friday or Monday
 - They close at 2 AM on weekdays and weekends

New Business

- BM Jennifer wanted to create a subcommittee for re-entry issues
 - Resources for people
 - Can have community people but a Board Member has to Chair the subcommittee
 - They must have 3-5 people and should inform the General Board
 - Wants to make a motion to create a subcommittee under Public Safety for re-entry issues
 - Motion was seconded and will be revisited at the January Meeting
- DM Rivera to have pushing to have a NYCHA Committee because there are a lot of NYCHA residents and makes up half of our district
 - Maybe move housing to Land & Zoning and just have Social Services
- Will have vans for NYPD by next year's National Night Out
 - o This will be for the community and NCO officers said they can share it

Old Business

- DOT Matters
 - Putting out lights on Watson and Wheeler Ave and additional traffic controls will be completed by April 30, 2019
 - Capital Project Increase
 - O'Brien Ave, Harding Park and certain parts in the district are sinking
 - This was in the District Needs Report but DM Rivera is starting the process by speaking to DOT and Parks on next steps and how much it'll cost
 - 1776 Mansion Ave, a school, requests No Standing or No Parking but there are signs at the school; however, they want more signs, so the teachers can park but DOE doesn't do it anymore. DM Rivera will check, so DOE might give the permits
 - Traffic on Story Ave and Bronx River Ave is an issue and there are complaints from residents, which are forwarded to DOT
 - DM River will work with NCO officers to help monitor throughout the district but it should be Traffic's responsibility
 - Bronx River Ave lane reduction made the traffic on the 174th bridge worse
 - News outlet called and DM Rivera told them about the overnight tractor trailers and waste trucks; they will help Will expose it on the news throughout the district
 - Regardless of signs, you can still give summons but DOT will go again to survey the area at midnight
 - If there are no standing signs, you can park until 8
 - o Barrett, Howe and Screbin Ave Modifications
 - Town Hall Meeting at the end of Castle Hill
 - Email sent to DOT but haven't responded yet
 - DOT is working on BM Jennifer's complaint and she asked if DM Rivera can send Navardo an email to make sure the issue is tended to
 - DM Rivera wrote email to all the city agencies on their lot requirements and will have meeting with the Council Member in Parkchester
 - Curbside pick-up has been removed and Parkchester agreed to do the transfer station; Sanitation will not renegotiate the contract; this seems completely out of CB9's hands

- Sanitation trucks can go in and out but can't make noise
- Soundview Ferry & DOT Letter @ Next General Board Meeting
 - BX39 bus will be extended all the way to the end
 - DOT Letter regarding all the issues that they have not been responding on and DM Rivera will CC the Mayor
- Izzy is the new Vice- Chair for the Public Safety Committee
