Mr. McLean began talking about the proposed space for the sensory park on Thieriot Avenue, he stated that this isn't a good location for the sensory park and the children shouldn't be hidden, and there also isn't a place for ambulette drop off. Mr. McLean also stated that 37% of kids with autism needs are in District 9 and is asking for the Bronx to do good for kids with special needs. DM Rivera stated that CB9 wants to support the sensory park and will put in District needs statement. Mr. Mclean stated that better programs are needed to adjust special needs children to the real world and there aren't not enough sensory gyms in the public schools either. Board Member Daniel Porro stated that Chris Noel is the chair of ADA compliance and he may be able to help out with the park. DM Rivera stated he will bring up Chris Noel when he speaks to Parks.
