- 2. DOT'S FINAL PLAN FOR THE GRAND STREET PROTECTED BIKE LANE DOT will be making the bike lanes along the Grand Street corridor in Brooklyn permanent. Between Waterbury Street and Vandervoort Avenue, DOT will modify the protected bike lanes to help accommodate the needs of industrial businesses along this section of the corridor.
