1) <u>The New York City Office of Environmental Remediation (OER) 83 Apollo Street</u> <u>Brooklyn, New York - 21CVCP045K</u>

An application for Voluntary Cleanup Program (VCP) has been submitted by 83-97 Apollo Owner LLC for enrollment of the property located at 83 Apollo Street in the Greenpoint neighborhood of Brooklyn, New York. The environmental investigation identified petroleum related compounds in soils, groundwater and in soil vapor. Soil vapor samples detected elevated volatile organic compounds, above the monitoring/mitigation level ranges established by the New York State Department of Health. The OER project manager will present and discuss the state of the site and the proposed remediation. An advisor from the NYC Department of Health and Mental Hygiene will be on hand and representatives from the Department of Homeless Services will be on hand as this site is being developed into a residential building that will provide shelter for homeless individuals.
