Hearing:

U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Draft Integrated Feasibility Report and Tier 1 Environmental Impact Statement. USACE is recommending storm risk management Alternative Plan 3B for New York New Jersey Harbor & Tributaries which includes installing a storm surge barrier across Newtown Creek and installing tie in structures such as seawalls, floodwalls and levees along the shoreline from Box Street to Kent St, traversing Newtown Barge Park and WNYC Transmitter Park, and parts of Dupont Street, Kent Street and Greenpoint Avenue.
