- One Way Conversion of Varick Avenue (southbound between Johnson Avenue and Flushing Avenue) INVO INT proposes to change Varick Avenue [between Johnson Avenue and Flushing Avenue] from a two way street to a one way street] (*Vote of the Board* <u>Requested</u>)
- **Boerum Street and Broadway** Project includes slip closure to reduce pedestrian crossing distance and parking alignment changes along Boerum St between Manhattan Avenue and Broadway. Parking changes result in +15 parking spaces. (*No Vote of the Board Requested*)
- Flushing Avenue between Humboldt St and Bushwick Avenue Project includes painted and concrete curb extensions at four intersections along Vision Zero Priority Corridor to shorten pedestrian crossing distances. (*No Vote of the Board Requested*)
- Flushing Avenue, Varick Avenue and Irving Avenue Project includes new pedestrian crosswalk on north curb of Flushing Avenue and Thames St, new concrete curb extension between Flushing Avenue and Melrose Street and proposal to convert Varick Avenue between Johnson Avenue and Thames St from two way to one way southbound. (*No Vote of the Board Requested*)
