Chairperson Lucy Mujica Diaz opened this month's meeting of Community Board 13 at 7 p.m. The agenda includes votes that were postponed from the March meeting when quorum was not present. This meeting is being recorded and anything in the Chat can be part of a FOIL if requested.

**PRESENTATION:** From Mayor's Office of Climate and Environmental Justice Elijah M. Hutchinson, Executive Director

He explained about this office takes care of policy and planning. The office reports to the Chief Resiliency Office and Commissioner of DEP. They receive grants from the Biden Administration. They receive project ideas and submit the ideas for funding. The office is five offices combined into one.

Ida Sanoff asked if the Community Board will have a seat at the table. She hopes that all the agencies involved make sure that our community has a seat at the table. Elijah said he knows our community well and understands our problems and concerns.

Jeff Sanoff remarked that the DEC has a air monitoring project, however they left off southern Brooklyn, which encompasses Coney Island and Brighton Beach. Could we possibly be included in this project. Elijah said he would check and get back to the office.

#### **PUBLIC SESSION:**

<u>Andrea Mitchell</u> – Mgr. Brighton Beach Branch BPL – Discussed many special programs the Brighton Beach Branch has and invited everyone to visit. She requested that the board send a letter to the Mayor not to cut funding to the library. Some of the special classes held at the library – English class, resume help, tax help, home internet, Work Force 1, SNAP, Crochet Corner.

Ronald Greenberg – He said he served as a board member a year ago. He read the letter sent from his attorney, who is a constitutional lawyer and a free speech expert. Lucy said the office contacted Legal at Borough Hall and were told that the fifty members of the community board are covered by the Legal Department and if Mr. Greenberg continues his harassment on this topic, it will not be accepted.

She has not received any response as of this date. There is a shortage of Crossing Guards city-wide. Our Pct has 20 less crossing guards than are needed. The Senator is co-sponsoring a bill to have crossing guards at each corner near all schools. ### **CHAIRPERSON'S REPORT:**

Lucy advised that tonight is Zunera's last meeting. She is resigning from the board because she has taken a position as Deputy Chief of Staff for CM Justin Brannan. Lucy wished her the best on behalf of the Board members.

Lucy reported that the Gambling Text Amendment passed the City Council this afternoon. There will be an Executive Committee meeting on Wednesday, May 29<sup>th</sup>. A representative of the Gambling Commission will make a presentation. Everyone is invited to attend. Location to be determined.

Jeff reported that in Lucy's absence, she asked him to attend several events. On March 24<sup>th</sup> he attended the Blessing of the Rides. He thanked the Vourderis Family for their kindness to the community. He also attended the ribbon cutting for the JCCGCI Trauma Center. This is a very important facility. It will assist many people in our neighborhood. It will bring a safe space for families who are dealing with violence, crime or trauma. We have several meetings in the month of May  $-8^{th}$  – Public Safety Meeting – update for summer,  $13^{th}$  - Transportation Meeting,  $16^{th}$  Land Use Meeting, and  $22^{nd}$  Board Meeting.

Sheila Smalls brought up the situation with the 36 Bus, sometimes the bus stops at W. 33<sup>rd</sup> St. and Mermaid and sometimes it does not. This began during the construction and although it should not be a problem anymore, bus drivers are not consistent. They should be stopping there. The problem is that now that block will be closed daily beginning April 22<sup>nd</sup> from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Eddie said he will talk to the MTA and get more clarification and advise the board.

Minnie Mankita brought up the incident where a 70 year old woman was hit by a bus on Stillwell Avenue and Mermaid Avenue. She wanted to know what could be done to make sure that this didn't happen again (crossing guard)..Eddie suggested she attend the Transportation Committee meeting.
