About the Program

Bridge to Health Careers (BTH) is a free language and job readiness training for immigrant English language learners who want to pursue a career in the healthcare field. Our intensive BTH course prepares students to:

- Improve English grammar, speaking and writing skills
- Explore community health issues and health care jobs
- Gain job readiness skills
- Receive OSHA 10-hour General Industry certification training and Mental Health First Aid Certificate

Upon successfully completing the course, students will receive help applying to healthcare training, health jobs, and connect with career counseling support.

Requirements

Applicants must meet all requirements:

- ☐ Be 21 + years old and live in NYC
- ☐ Be an English language learner with a high level of English in speaking, reading, and writing .
- ☐ Be authorized to work legally in the U.S.
- ☐ Have a HS Diploma or equivalent abroad or the U.S.
