Saturday, September 22nd, 11:00 am to 1:00 pm

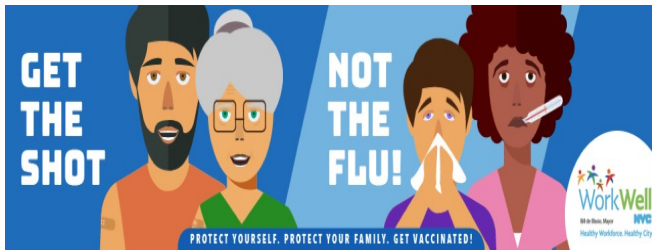

The [Work, Learn & Grow Employment Program](#) (WLG) is a New York City Council-funded initiative designed to build off of the experiences gained in the Summer Youth Employment Program (SYEP). WLG provides 2018 SYEP participants who are between the ages of 16 – 21 and currently in-school with career readiness training and paid employment opportunities for up to twenty-five weeks from October to April.
