

Come and explore the winding paths of historic The Evergreens Cemetery on a walking tour led by James Henry. Visit the gravesities of notable residents—who reflect the racial and religious diversity of New York City—including artists, actors, musicians and entertainers as well as some controversial personalities. Learn about Victorian funerary symbols and styles as well as secret societies and their mysterious memorials. The tour will also include a trip inside normally "off-limits" Receiving Vault as well as other surprises.

Where can I get a flu shot?

NYC employees have four options for receiving their **free** flu shot: the workplace, participating pharmacies, in-network physicians and <u>AdvantageCare Physicians</u> (ACPNY) medical offices. Dependents and pre-Medicare retirees are also covered.

Work, Learn & Grow



The Work, Learn & Grow Employment Program (WLG) is a New York City Council-funded initiative designed to build off of the experiences gained in the Summer Youth Employment Program (SYEP). WLG provides 2018 SYEP participants who are between the ages of 16 – 21 and currently in-school with career readiness training and paid employment opportunities for up to twenty-five weeks from October to April. Youth can apply for the program online now, participants are selected by lottery for the program. For more information visit the WLG official website.

Train & Earn



Train & Earn is a short-term career pathway program for low-income youth, ages 16–24, who are not working and not in school. Train & Earn provides extensive job training and employment services along with support services needed by participants to find a permanent job or assistance with college admission. 
